Annual Earlham Fire Department Report

2017

Summary- This report is a look back at the activities and functions of the Earlham Fire Department over the 2017 calendar year. We hope that this report gives you a better understanding of the functions and activities that go on with the department.

On behalf of the men and women whom proudly serve this community, Thank you for your continued support.

Operations- The operations section is the most visible part within the department to the community. The highly trained first responders specialize in fire mitigation, hazardous materials incidents motor vehicle accidents and specialized rescue techniques and severe weather emergencies. The department responded to 94 calls this past year. We are up by 21 calls from last year.

23 active and 2 reserve fire fighters make up our roster. 20 active members are certified at or above the fire fighter 1 level. 3 members joined the ranks last year all of whom are awaiting fire fighting classes to become certified. Collectively, 823 fire fighters responded to alarms this past year for Earlham FD. This gave the department an average response to alarms at 8.75 fire fighters per alarm.

Training- The State of Iowa requires that all structural fire fighters receive a minimum of 24 hours of annual training. The department meets monthly for a training session lasting a minimum of 2 each session. The members of the department accumulated 662 hours of training for the year.

Last spring the Fire Service Training Bureau had a shake up within the organization. Testing scores were incorrectly entered in the computer system giving over 1500 fire fighters across the state of lowal including 3 from Earlham False passing grades. Each member was notified of the problem and was asked to re-test at no cost to the departments. As of Dec.31, 2017 2 of the 3 have since

learned that they have passed there FF1 certification with hazardous materials endorsements.

Administrative- Once again, Shawn Boyle was elected by the department as the Fire Chief. The City Council also, recommended him as the Chief and the Mayor appointed Shawn Boyle as Fire Chief for 2017. A banquet was held in January to honor the men and women of the department for their individual achievements. Several award for service were given out to members who had served for 5, 10, 15, 20, 25 and 40 years. Jake Royster was awarded the FF of the year for 2017.

During 2017, Gavin Boyle, Rachelle Keller and Joel Visser joined the EFD. Joel came to Earlham from the Iowa Falls FD with several years of experience under his belt. Gavin and Rachelle are probationary FF's awaiting certification classes.

Back in 2016 ISO (Insurance Safety Offices) conducted an inspection of our department and classifications are given out on the status of each department. Along with the help of public works the city council and the fire department our classification rose to a 5Y in 2017. Our previous classification was a 7x. This means that all of our service area could see reductions in fire insurance for your property.

In March of 2017, the department was given notice that the Dallas County 911 board was purchasing new 700 mega hertz radios for all mobile units a base station and 6 handheld radios. This is conjunction with the Statewide Interoperability Communications Network. Madison County is currently working on going to this system but thanks to Dallas County no money from Earlham will have to be spent on upgrades in the near future. This grant had a value of \$58,000.00.

In May, the city council purchased a new attack truck for the department. The purchase was made possible due to the old grass truck having numerous mechanical issues. The purchase was bumped up a couple of months due to a heavy grass fire season we were experiencing.

Throughout the summer the department as placing flags around town for the Lion' safety education events at KOA campgrowell as helping with Freedom Fest activitievents for fire suppression at the Madiso

As you can see the Earlham Fire Departm running emergencies. It has been a busy looks to run the same.

Once again, Thank you to the Mayor and name of public safety.
