They can help us update our zoning ordinance so we would mirror the State Code. Mayor Lillie asked what benefit inspections would be for the city. VanAusdall stated it would protect our citizens on what is possible the biggest purchase of their life. Mayor Lillie added he believes our local builders are good builders. The inspections would help protect us from any builders coming into the area who might think they can get by with a lesser quality of work. Jason suggested we have 3 readings of the Building Department Services Agreement, to give builders/public the opportunity to ask questions. Readings will be in April, May & June, so we can begin inspections on July 1, 2019. Consensus of Committee is to recommend the building inspection services provided by Veenstra & Kim to the council.
