

ORDINANCE NO. 420

AN ORDINANCE CORRECTING ORDINANCE NO. 415, CHANGING ALL REFERENCES TO ORDINANCE 281 TO ORDINANCE 282 DUE TO SCRIVENER ERROR

SECTION 1.

WHEREAS, the City of Earlham adopted Ordinance No 415, An Ordinance Repealing Ordinance No. 281 Providing for the Division of Taxes Levied on Taxable Property in The City Of Earlham Urban Renewal Area, City Of Earlham, Iowa, Pursuant To Section 403.19 Of The Code Of Iowa, on November 5, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No 281 is an ordinance amending the Earlham Code of Ordinances to redefine the duties and rulemaking authority of the Parks and Recreation Board, and not as described above; and,

WHEREAS, due to scrivener error, it should have been Ordinance No 282 repealed by Ordinance No 415, and not Ordinance No. 281.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EARLHAM, STATE OF IOWA, that all refences in Ordinance 415 to Ordinance No 281 shall be changed to Ordinance No 282, and Ordinance No 281 shall continue to be in effect.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect March 9, 2020.
