ORDINANCE NO. 440

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF EARLHAM, IOWA, 2017, CHAPTER 24 COMMUNITY CENTER BOARD

Be It Enacted by the City Council of the City of Earlham, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION AMENDED. Chapter 24.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Earlham, Iowa, 2017, is here by deleted and replaced by the following:

24.03 ORGANIZATION. The Board shall consist of seven members, four of whom shall be residents of the City and three of whom may (but need not be) nonresidents. All members of the Board shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Council. All members shall serve for staggered five-year terms. To implement staggered terms, two members of the initial board shall serve for two years, two members of the initial board shall serve for five years. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments. Members shall serve without compensation, but may receive their actual expenses. The Board shall elect its own Chairperson, Secretary, and Treasurer every two years, at the first meeting of the year.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
