



The Earlham Fire Department had an extremely busy year in 2022. EFD responded to 111 calls for service which is 47 more calls than 2021. 845 Fire fighters responded to calls for service giving us an average response of 7.61 ff/run. We averaged 9.73 minutes for response time to the scene and a 5 minute out the door time.

All members are trained to a minimum of Fire Fighter 1. Over half of our 20 person roster have obtained their Fire Fighter 2 Certification and higher. The department meets the first Tuesday of each month for a regular training session hour a minimum of 2 hours allowing for each member to obtain 24 hours per year in training hours. Most members seek additional training at locally with Mutual Aid departments and regionally at Fire Schools held throughout the State or have furthered their Fire Science Education at the college level.
